Mr. Bohrer advised the Board that, per his discussion with the Auditor, the 2016 audit is expected to be completed in a week.

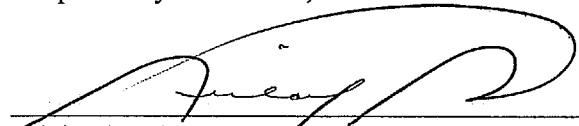

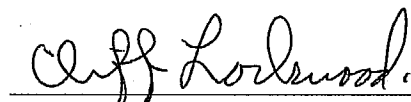
