

**MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE
BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS
TOWNSHIP OF DENNIS, DISTRICT #2**

April 2, 2019

A meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Township of Dennis, District #2, was held on April 2, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. at the Dennisville Volunteer Fire Company in Dennisville, New Jersey.

Commissioners **Cliff Lockwood, Carla Coffey, Ed Beck and Bruce Knoll, Jr.** were present. Commissioner **Bob McClure** arrived toward the end of the meeting, Accountant and Recording Secretary to the Board, **Cheryl Ward, CPA,** and **Board Solicitor, Jon Batastini, Esquire,** were unable to attend. Also present was Fire Company Chief, **Michael Gihorski.**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Cliff Lockwood, who read the appropriate notice in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act of the State of New Jersey.

Mr. Lockwood then advised all members present that he had changed the wall calendar from March to April.

A motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting held on March 5, 2019 was made by Mr. Knoll, seconded by Mr. Beck and unanimously approved. Mr. Knoll commented about his name being mentioned in the minutes regarding the fact "that July 4th will occur on the 4th this year."

A list of checks to be disbursed was presented. The checks were approved as presented.

It was noted that the quarterly check from the Township has not yet been received. This raised some concern among the members. The Township Committee's next meeting is scheduled for April 9, 2019. Will follow-up with Township if no check received following that meeting.

A discussion was held with respect to increasing the amount of the LOSAP contribution. The hand-outs provided by Ms. Ward were reviewed, but there are still some questions regarding the process and the Commissioners would like to discuss this matter further. It was also suggested that Mr. Batastini be contacted for his legal opinion and attendance at the next meeting. In any event, it appears that nothing can be done to increase the amount until 2020.


Ms. Ward's office was advised by Thomas Laughlin of the Power of Production Studio that his company would no longer be handling the posting of minutes and agendas for the Fire District on the Township's website. The Township was contacted for further information about where our minutes and agendas should be sent for posting on the Township's website, but we were advised that no information is available at this time. When the information is confirmed, we will be advised.

The meeting was then opened to the public. Chief Mike Gihorski was present but had nothing to report.


There being no further business for the Board, the regular meeting was adjourned at 7:24 p.m.
