WHEREAS, the Annual Budget for the Dennis Township Fire District No. 2 (the "Fire District") for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2019 has been presented before the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District at its open public meeting of November 5, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the budget as introduced is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44 et. seq.) *[Include the following as appropriate: [includes a proposed public referendum in the amount of \$0.00 in excess of the allowable amount to be raised by taxation] [includes a proposed public referendum in the amount of \$0.00 as an appropriation from restricted fund balance to be used as budget revenue]]*; and



WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District, at an open public meeting held on November 5, 2018 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2019 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the Fire District's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District will consider the Annual Budget for adoption on December 4, 2018.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Annual Budget as presented for adoption reflects each item of revenue and appropriation in the same amount and title as set forth in the introduced and approved budget, including all amendments thereto, if any, which have been approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an annual election shall be held on the third Saturday of February to determine the amount to be raised by taxation for the ensuing year. The results of which shall be subsequently certified to the Division and the Municipal Assessor.

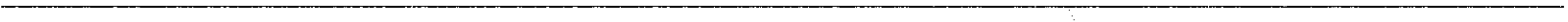
