

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE
BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS
TOWNSHIP OF DENNIS, DISTRICT #2

February 5, 2019

A meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Township of Dennis, District #2, was held on February 5, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. at the Dennisville Volunteer Fire Company in Dennisville, New Jersey.

Commissioners Carla Coffey, Ed Beck and Bruce Knoll, Jr. were present. Commissioners Cliff Lockwood and Bob McClure, Accountant and Recording Secretary to the Board, Cheryl Ward, CPA, and Board Solicitor, Jon Batastini, Esquire, were unable to attend. Also present was Fire Company Chief, Michael Gihorski.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Vice-Chairman Ed Beck.

The minutes from the last meeting held on January 8, 2019 were approved.

A list of checks to be disbursed was presented. The checks were approved as presented.

A discussion was held with respect to the Agreement with the County of Cape May for the resale of fuel. Although it is Mr. Batastini's opinion that the Agreement should be between the County and the Dennis Volunteer Fire Company, it is the opinion of this Board that the Agreement should be between the County and this Board. The reason for this opinion being that the Commission owns the trucks and pays for the fuel. Further discussion will be held at the March, 2019 meeting.


The Fire District Elections will be held on February 16, 2019 from 2:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Due to changes in legislation regarding absentee/mail-in ballots, this District had to provide 90 ballots to the County for distribution, as opposed to between 10 and 20 in past years. Everyone was urged to come out and vote.


The meeting was then opened to the public. Chief Mike Gihorski was present but had nothing to report.
