Roll Call- Present were Commission Members John Berg, Chairman, Joe Gurdgiel, Vice Chairman, Robert Clayton, Secretary, Doreen Gregory, Treasurer and Don Tozer, Commissioner. Also present was Financial Advisor Joe Willshire.

Secretary's Report- Minuets of the previous meeting were read and a motion to accept them was made by Doreen Gregory and seconded by Don Tozer. This motion was approved by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Treasurer's Report- The treasurer's report was read, accepted by the commission and attached to the minutes. The following bills were presented for payment.

Old Business- Joe Gurdgiel introduced the fire coverage contract which calls for the Ocean View Volunteer Fire Company to provide fire coverage to the residents and businesses of Dennis Township Fire District No. 1. Also to respond to any and all emergencies that occur with in the boundaries of the district. This contract will be in affect for 1 year from today. For providing this service the fire co. will receive \$40,000.00 quarterly. This contract was signed by John Berg, Chairman and attested by Robert Clayton, Secretary for Fire District No. 1 and by David McMichael, President and attested by Michael DeLuca, Secretary for the Ocean View Volunteer Fire Co.
