

**MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE  
BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS  
TOWNSHIP OF DENNIS, DISTRICT #2**

**May 7, 2019**

A meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Township of Dennis, District #2, was held on May 7, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. at the Dennisville Volunteer Fire Company in Dennisville, New Jersey.

Commissioners **Cliff Lockwood, Carla Coffey, Ed Beck and Bruce Knoll, Jr.** were present. Commissioner **Bob McClure**, Accountant and Recording Secretary to the Board, **Cheryl Ward, CPA**, and **Board Solicitor, Jon Batastini, Esquire**, were unable to attend. Also present was Fire Company Chief, **Michael Gihorski** and **Robert Brewer**.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Cliff Lockwood, who read the appropriate notice in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act of the State of New Jersey.

A motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting held on April 2, 2019 was made, seconded and unanimously approved.

A list of checks to be disbursed was presented. The checks were approved as presented.

There was a discussion concerning the District's website, which is accessed through the Township's website. The Township has hired a new company to run the website, but, according to the Township Clerk, the Fire District's information to be posted is to continue to be forwarded to the previous company (Power of Production Studio/Thomas Laughlin) until further notice. Mr. Laughlin has advised the District that no further information is to be sent to him. The concern now arises that the District may be without a website and unable to post necessary information. If not resolved soon, it was suggested that the District use the Fire Company's website to post the information to keep itself within the law. The situation will continue to be monitored.

Mr. Knoll advised that an active DVFC member, Adam Dotts, who now lives in the Ocean View District and primarily runs with Ocean View, would like to combine his LOSAP accounts with each company into one account with Ocean View. Ms. Ward will be asked to check into this to see if it is possible and what, if any, problems could arise.

It was suggested the Mr. Batastini be in attendance at the July 2, 2019 meeting to discuss an increase in the LOSAP contribution.

A letter was received from the Brown and Brown Insurance Company asking if there were any changes to information they had on file. It was determined that there were not and no response

was necessary as the letter indicated that if they heard nothing, they would assume that all information remains the same.

A question was also asked as to exactly what the policy with Brown and Brown covered. Mr. Beck is going to look into this and report back at the next meeting. Mr. Beck is also going to check into what the JIF policy covers.

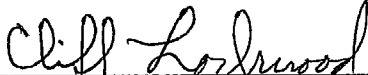
The meeting was then opened to the public. Chief Mike Gihorski and Robert Brewer were present but had nothing to report.
