A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners for Dennis Township Fire District No. 1 was opened at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman John Berg with the statement that we were compliant with the Sunshine Act and notice of the meeting was posted in town hall. He then led those assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call- Present were Commission Members John Berg, Chairman, Joe Gurdgiel, Assistant Chairman, Robert Clayton, Secretary and Don Tozer, Commissioner. Also present was Financial Advisor Joe Willshire. Absent was Treasurer Doreen Gregory.

Secretary's Report- Minuets of the previous meeting were read and a motion to accept was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Joe Gurdgiel. This motion was approved by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Treasurer's Report- The treasurer's report was read, accepted by the commission and attached to the minuets. The following bills were read and presented for payment.

Motion to pay bills was made by Joe Gurdgiel and seconded by Don Tozer. This motion was passed by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Chief's Report- John Berg read the Chief's Report which showed 7 incidents for the month of March. 1 medical assist., 1 alarm, 3 mva's and 2 fires.

Old Business- John Berg reported on the results of the election, which won't be official till 4 p.m. on Thursday the 22 of April. Don Tozer received 68 votes. Jesse Gery received 62 votes. The budget received 54 yes votes and 9 no votes. Joe Willshire reported that the state had approved our budget pending the results of the election.

New Business- Deputy Chief Adam Dotts reported that the new truck was started and should be finished by the end of July. Jesse Gery reported that Tanker 17 is going to be repaired by Peterbilt as warranty work. We are just waiting for a time.

Good of the Commission- Nothing to Report.

Public Comment- No public comment.

There being no further business to come before this commission a motion to adjourn was made Don Tozer and seconded by Joe Gurdgiel. This motion was approved by a unanimous vote of the commission and the meeting adjourned at 7:09 p.m.
