

May 19, 2021

A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners for Dennis Township Fire District No. 1 was opened at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman John Berg with the statement that we were compliant with the Sunshine Act and notice of the meeting was posted in town hall. He then led those assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call- Present were Commission Members John Berg, Chairman, Robert Clayton, Secretary and Don Tozer, Commissioner and newly elected commissioner Jesse Gery. Also present was Financial Advisor Joe Willshire. Absent was Vice Chairman Joe Gurdgiel.

Reorganization- At this time Don Tozer and Jesse Gery were sworn in by phone with Solicitor Jon Batastini. The reorganization of Fire District No. 1 is as follows;

John Berg elected Chairman, Nominated by Don Tozer, second by Jesse Gery, unanimous vote of commission.

Joe Gurdgiel elected Vice Chairman, Nominated by John Berg, second by Jesse Gery, unanimous vote of commission.

Don Tozer elected Treasurer, Nominated by John Berg, second by Jesse Gery, unanimous vote of commission.

Robert Clayton elected Secretary, Nominated by Jesse Gery, second by Don Tozer, unanimous vote of commission.

Don Tozer made a motion the Herald be our primary newspaper and the Atlantic City Press our secondary newspaper. Seconded by Jesse Gery, unanimous vote of commission.

Don Tozer made a motion that we use Ford – Scott Associates as our auditor. Seconded by Jesse Gery, unanimous vote of commission.

John Berg made a motion that appoint Jon Batastini as our solicitor. Seconded by Jesse Gery, unanimous vote of commission.

Secretary's Report- Minuets of the previous meeting were read and a motion to accept was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Jesse Gery. This motion was approved by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Treasurer's Report- The treasurer's report was read, accepted by the commission and attached to the minuets. The following bills were read and presented for payment.

Fire and Safety	\$734.83

Motion to pay bills was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Jesse Gery. This motion was passed by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Chief's Report- John Berg read the Chief's Report which showed 13 incidents for the month of April. 3 medical assist., 2 alarms, 4 mva's and 3 fires and 1 canceled en route.

Old Business- John Berg reported on the results of the election. They stayed the same after they became official. Don Tozer and Jesse Gery elected to the commission and the budget for 2021 passed.

New Business- John Berg reported that the price of the new extrication tools needed for the new truck was \$37,064.75. John Berg questioned the commission members about how they felt about the fire company using trucks to fill swimming pools. None of the commission members have a problem with it because it is used as driver and pump training. Jesse Gery reported that Fire and Safety quoted a price of \$1,168.00 to install mesh netting on the cross lays for Squad 17. This was unanimously approved by the commission.

Good of the Commission- Nothing to Report.

Public Comment- No public comment.

There being no further business to come before this commission a motion to adjourn was made Don Tozer and seconded by Jesse Gery. This motion was approved by a unanimous vote of the commission and the meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
