Roll Call- Present were Commission members John Berg, Chairman, Joseph Gurdgiel, Vice Chairman, Robert Clayton, Secretary, Don Tozer, Treasurer and Jesse Gery, Commissioner. Also present was Financial Advisor Joseph Wilshire.

Secretary's Report- Minutes of the previous meeting were read and a motion to accept them as read was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Joe Gurdgiel. This motion was passed by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Treasurer's Report- The treasurer's report was read, accepted by the commission and attached to the minutes. The following bills were presented for payment.

A motion to pay the bills was made by Joe Gurdgiel and seconded by Jesse Gery. By a unanimous vote of the commission the motion was carried and the bills were paid.

Chief's Report- John Berg read the Chief's report which showed 10 incidents for the month of December totaling 5.5 hrs. 3 ems assists, 1 mva, 1 building fire, 1 co alarm, 1 fire alarm, 1 hazardous condition, 1 steam and 1 power line down.

Old Business- Joe Willshire reported that the adopted budget has been submitted to the state for approval.

New Business- Robert Clayton reported that he had received a letter to the commission from Chief Neely reporting that 21 members of the Ovvfc had qualified for LOSAP in 2023. John Berg reminded all those present about the Budget approval and election on February 17, 2024

There being no further business to come before this commission, a motion to adjourn was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Jesse Gery. This motion was passed unanimously by the commission and the meeting adjourned at 7:11 p.m.
