A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners for Dennis Township Fire District No. 1 was opened at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman John Berg with the statement that we were compliant with the Sunshine Act and notice of the meeting was posted in the Town Hall. He then led those assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call- Present were Commission Members John Berg Chairman, Joe Gurdgiel, Vice Chairman, Bob Clayton, Secretary, Don Tozer, Treasurer and Jesse Gery, Commissioner. Also present was Financial Advisor Joe Willshire.

Secretary's Report- Minutes of the previous meeting were read and a motion to accept them as read was made by Jesse Gery and seconded by Don Tozer. This motion was passed by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Treasurer's Report- The treasurer's report was read, accepted by the commission, and attached to the minutes. The following bills were presented for payment.

Chief's Report- John Berg read the Chief's Report which showed 27 incidents for the month of June totaling 14.4 hours. 5 MVA's, 4 EMS assists, 4 alarms, 4 gas leaks, 2 public service, 1 building fire, 1 brush fire, 1 lightning strike, 1 co alarm, 1 cover assignment, 1 hazardous condition, 1 canceled enroute and 1 nothing found. The Chief reported that pump testing would be taking place on Saturday, July 20, 2024, all day in South Seaville.

New Business- Joe Willshire presented the 15-year plan for the commissioner's consideration. It was discussed briefly, received, and will be attached to the minutes. Joe will have a revised version available for the August meeting.
