A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners for Dennis Township Fire District No. 1 was opened at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman John Berg with the statement that we were compliant with the Sunshine Act and notice of the meeting was posted in the Town Hall. He then led those assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call- Present were Commission Members John Berg, Chairman, Joseph Gurdziel, Vice Chairman, Robert Clayton, Secretary, Don Tozer, Treasurer and Jesse Gery, Commissioner. Also present was Janet Webster from the CPA's office.

Secretary's Report- Minutes of the previous meeting were read and a motion to accept them as read was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Jesse Gery. This motion was passed by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Treasurer's Report- The treasurer's report was read and accepted by the commission. The following bills were presented for payment.

The commissioners will discuss this and decide what to do.

Chief's Report- John Berg read the Chief's Report which showed 16 incidents for the month of May. 1 down wire, 3 fire alarms, 1 landing zone, 2 residential structure fires, 3 ems assists, 1 mva with entrapment, 1 missing person, 2 mva with no injuries and 2 medical assistance calls.
