Secretary's Report- Minutes of the previous meeting were read and a motion to accept them as read was made by Don Tozer and seconded by John Berg. This motion was passed by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Treasurer's Report- The treasurer's report was read and accepted by the commission. The following bills were presented for payment.

A motion to pay the bills was made by Jesse Gery and seconded by Robert Clayton. The motion was unanimously passed by the commission and the bills were paid. Jesse Gery made a motion that we roll the CD over Robert Clayton seconded the motion which was unanimously passed by the Commission.
