A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners for Dennis Township Fire District No. 1 was opened at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman John Berg with the statement that we were compliant with the Sunshine Act and notice of the meeting was posted in the Town Hall. He then led those assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call- Present were Commission Members John Berg, Chairman, Joseph Gurdgiel, Vice Chairman, Robert Clayton, Secretary, Don Tozer, Treasurer and Jesse Gery, Commissioner. Also present was Janet Webster from the CPA's office.

Secretary's Report- Minutes of the previous meeting were read and a motion to accept them as read was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Jesse Gery. This motion was passed by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Treasurer's Report- The treasurer's report was read and accepted by the commission. The following bills were presented for payment.

A motion to pay the bills was made by Joe Gurdgiel and seconded by Jesse Gery. The motion was unanimously passed by the commission and the bills were paid.

Chief's Report- John Berg read the Chief's Report which showed 23 incidents for the month of June. 8 Fire Alarms, 1 Carbon Monoxide Alarm, 2 Landing Zones, 2 Commercial Structure Fires, 1 Residential Structure Fire, 4 EMS Assists, 2 Service Calls (Investigation), 1 MV Crash W/Injuries and 2 MV Crash W/No Injuries. The Chief also reminded us of the upcoming hose and pump test.

Old Business – After a brief discussion it was decided that the Commission could get by without a debit card.

New Business- John Berg brought up the possibility of raising the LOSAP payment. After a short discussion it was decided to raise the annual LOSAP payment from \$1,550.00 to \$1,750.00. Jesse Gery made this a motion. Don Tozor seconded the motion which was passed unanimously by the commission.

Good of the Commission- Nothing to report.

Public Comment- Nothing to report.

There being no further business to come before this commission, a motion to adjourn was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Jesse Gery. This motion was passed unanimously by the commission and the meeting adjourned at 7:09 p.m.
