A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners for Dennis Township Fire District No. 1 was opened at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman John Berg with the statement that we were compliant with the Sunshine Act and notice of the meeting was posted in the Town Hall. He then led those assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call- Present were Commission Members John Berg, Chairman, Joseph Gurdgiel, Vice Chairman, Robert Clayton, Secretary, Don Tozer, Treasurer and Commissioner Jesse Gery. Also present was Cheryl Sayers from the CPA's office.

Secretary's Report- Minutes of the previous meeting were read and a motion to accept them as read was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Jesse Gery. This motion was passed by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Treasurer's Report- The treasurer's report was read and accepted by the commission. The following bills were presented for payment.

A motion to pay the bills was made by Joe Gurdgiel and seconded by Jesse Gery. The motion was unanimously passed by the Commission and the bills were paid.

Chief's Report- John Berg read the Chief's Report which showed 24 incidents for the month of September. 8 Fire Alarms, 1 Carbon Monoxide Alarm, 1 Waterflow Alarm, 1 Landing Zone, 1 Commercial Structure Fire, 2 Residential Structure Fires, 1 Odor of Gas, 1 MVA with entrapment, 1 Service Call – Investigation, 2 MVA with injuries, 1 MVA with no injuries, 1 MVA Pedestrian, 3 Medical Assistance.

Old Business – No old business to discuss.

New Business- John read resolution 25-13 which allows the Commission members to receive compensation in sum of \$1,200.00 annually. Jesse Gery made a motion to accept this resolution. Don Tozer seconded the motion which was then passed unanimously by the Commission. Cheryl introduced the 2026 budget which shows an increase of \$4,700.00 to \$481,000.00 with \$473,280.00 raised by taxation. This budget was discussed briefly, and an amended budget will be presented for approval at the November meeting.

Good of the Commission- Nothing to report.

Public Comment- Nothing to report.

There being no further business to come before this commission, a motion to adjourn was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Jesse Gery. This motion was passed unanimously by the commission and the meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
