A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners for Dennis Township Fire District No. 1 was opened at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman John Berg with the statement that we were compliant with the Sunshine Act and notice of the meeting was posted in the Town Hall. He then led those assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call- Present were Commission Members John Berg, Chairman, Joe Gurdgiel, Vice Chairman, Robert Clayton, Secretary, Don Tozer, Treasurer and Commissioner Jesse Gery. Also present was Cheryl Sayers from the CPA's office.

Secretary's Report- Minutes of the previous meeting were read and a motion to accept them as read was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Jesse Gery. This motion was passed by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Treasurer's Report- The treasurer's report was read and accepted by the commission. The following bills were presented for payment.

A motion to pay the bills was made by Joe Gurdgiel and seconded by Jesse Gery. The motion was unanimously passed by the Commission. Cheryl stated that since we were having trouble trying to get a CD with Franklin Savings, she was just going to get it with The First Bank of Sea Isle. Cheryl also stated that our Budget was ok and was waiting for Township approval to be sent to the state. She said we needed to Adopt our 2026 Budget. Joe Gurdgiel made a motion to adopt and Jesse Gery seconded. By unanimous agreement the 2026 Budget was adopted. John read the temporary budget which covers the Commission until February 21, 2026. Jesse Gery made a motion to accept the temporary budget. Joe Gurdgiel seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by the Commission. Cheryl brought up the contract with her firm which was due to expire. Jesse Gery made a motion to approve the new Contract for CPA services at a cost of \$520.00 per meeting. Don Tozer seconded the motion which was unanimously passed by the Commission.

John Berg read the Chief's report which showed 20 incidents for the month of November. 3 Fire Alarms, 1 Landing Zone, 1 Brush Fire, 1 Odor of Gas, 2 MVA's with Entrapment, 1 Cover Assignment, 3 MVA's with no injuries, 1 Medical Assist. and 7 Medical Assists (ALS).
