A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners for Dennis Township Fire District No. 1 was opened at 7:00 p.m. by Vice Chairman Joe Gurdgiel with the statement that we were compliant with the Sunshine Act and notice of the meeting was posted in the Town Hall. He then led those assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call- Present were Commission Members Joe Gurdgiel, Vice Chairman, Robert Clayton, Secretary, Don Tozer, Treasurer and Commissioner Jesse Gery. Also present was Cheryl Sayers from the CPA's office. Absent was John Berg Chairman.

Secretary's Report- Minutes of the previous meeting were read and a motion to accept them as read was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Jesse Gery. This motion was passed by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Treasurer's Report- The treasurer's report was read and accepted by the commission. The following bills were presented for payment.

Joe Gurdgiel read the Chief's report which showed 20 incidents for the month of December. 9 Fire Alarms, 1 Fire, Residential Structure, 4 Fumes, Odor of Gas, 1 EMS Assist, 1 MVA with Entrapment, 2 MVA's with No Injuries and 2 Medical Assists (ALS). The Chief also reported that the Fire Co. had responded to 242 calls in 2025. Also, 27 Fire Fighters had qualified for the LOSAP program in 2025.
