A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners for Dennis Township Fire District No. 1 was opened at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman John Berg with the statement that we were compliant with the Sunshine Act and notice of the meeting was posted in the Town Hall. He then led those assembled in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call- Present were Commission Members John Berg, Chairman, Joe Gurdgiel, Vice Chairman, Robert Clayton, Secretary and Don Tozer, Treasurer. Also present was Cheryl Sayers from the CPA's office. Absent was Jesse Gery Commissioner.

Secretary's Report- Minutes of the previous meeting were read and a motion to accept them as read was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Joe Gurdgiel. This motion was passed by a unanimous vote of the commission.

Treasurer's Report- The treasurer's report was read and accepted by the commission. The following bills were presented for payment.

A motion to pay the bills was made by Joe Gurdgiel and seconded by Robert Clayton. The motion was unanimously passed by the Commission. Cheryl also reported that we have a CD about to expire and thought we should roll it over. After a brief discussion it was decided to roll it over.

Chief's Report – John Berg read the Chief's report which showed 23 calls for the month January. 3 Fire Alarms, 1 Commercial Structure Fire, 1 Residential Structure Fire, 2 Vehicle Fires, 1 Wires / Transformer / Electrical Fire, 2 Odor of Gas, 1 Smoke Condition, 1 MVC with Entrapment, 2 MVC with no Injuries, 1 Medical Assistance, 7 Medical Assistance (ALS) and 1 Non-Cat Data.

Old Business – None

New Business- John read Resolution 26-01 which provides for moving funds for the 2025 Budget. \$1,450.00 was moved from Insurance and Administration. \$700.00 was moved to Professional Services and \$750.00 was moved to Miscellaneous. A motion was made by Joe Gurdziel to approve this Resolution. Robert Clayton seconded the motion which was then unanimously approved by the Commission. John then reminded everyone about the Commission Election and Budget approval on Saturday, February 21.

There being no further business to come before this commission, a motion to adjourn was made by Don Tozer and seconded by Joe Gurdziel. This motion was passed unanimously by the commission and the meeting adjourned at 7:11 p.m.
